Adjunct Instructor of Music, North Central College
Guest Director, 2023 MSC Jazz Band

Tim Coffman is one of the most active trombonists and teachers in the Chicago area. A graduate of the prestigious Jazz Studies program at Indiana University, Mr. Coffman worked closely with David Baker and Keith Brown. He was awarded the Performer's Certificate after his Senior Recital.

Mr. Coffman is in demand for studio and show work and has performed with Frank Sinatra, Frank Sinatra, Jr., Andy Williams, Natalie Cole, Lou Rawls, The Temptations, The O'Jays, Barry Manilow, Louie Bellson, The Woody Herman Orchestra, Frank Wess, Bassist Ron Carter, Johnny Griffin, Kurt Elling, Von Freeman, Tito Puente, Tom Harrell, Johnny Mathis, Paul Anka, Al Jarreau, Henry Mancini, Stevie Wonder, Diane Schur, Jimmy Heath, Randy Brecker, Benny Golson, Toshiko Akiyoshi, Joe Lovano, Lennie Niehaus, Slide Hampton, Diana

Krall, Tony Bennett and Lady Gaga, Aretha Franklin and many others. He performed in the pit for the world premiere of "The Producers" and also performed with the Chicago Symphony playing Lead Trombone in the Duke Ellington "Nutcracker." He also performed on the recording of "Porgy and Bess" featuring Clark Terry and the Chicago Jazz Orchestra. This recording was nominated for Jazz Album of the Year by the Jazz Journalists Association. In 2009, Mr. Coffman performed with the WDR Big Band in Cologne, Germany for two weeks, with special guest Arturo Sandoval. In 2022, Mr. Coffman was on tour with Wynton Marsalis and the Jazz at Lincoln Center Orchestra.

Mr. Coffman started teaching in the fall of 2015 at North Central College in Naperville, IL where he directs the big band and teaches applied arranging and composition lessons and applied jazz and classical trombone lessons. He is also the Jazz Studies Coordinator at North Central.

Mr. Coffman was a member of the Jazz Studies faculty at DePaul University from 1997-2021. There he taught jazz trombone, jazz improvisation, jazz history, low brass techniques and coached jazz combos. Before teaching at DePaul, he taught at New Trier High School as the trombone instructor and directed several jazz improvisation classes from 1990-2001. Mr. Coffman was also on faculty at Northwestern University during the 2015-2016 school year substituting for Vincent Gardner as the applied jazz trombone instructor. He was a regular member of the Rob Parton Big Band and the Chicago Jazz Ensemble formerly led by Jon Faddis. He is now a member of the New Standard Jazz Orchestra, the Bob Lark Alumni Big Band and the Bob Lark Septet.

Mr. Coffman is excited to be an XO Brass Artist/Clinician. XO Brass is the professional line of Jupiter Music. He is playing on the new jazz trombones designed by John Fedchock, the model 1632-LT and the model 1634-LT. He also performs on the model 1240-L bass trombone. In addition, Mr. Coffman is an artist for Denis Wick mouthpieces and plays those exclusively. Mr. Coffman has performed/adjudicated at various high schools, jazz festivals and universities including Evanston HS, Rolling Meadows HS, Mundelein HS, Oak Park-River Forest HS, Wheeling HS, Purdue University, Furman University, The University of Wisconsin-River Falls, The University of New Mexico, DePauw University, The University of Wisconsin-Stevens Point, Ball State University, and many others. In January of 2017, Mr. Coffman was the Artist in Residence for the Purdue University Jazz Festival.

He completed his first recording entitled Crossroads, available on the Blujazz label. In the summer, he teaches at the Jamey Aebersold Summer Jazz Workshop at the University of Louisville. He has been on the faculty since 1992. Mr. Coffman is married to Becky and has two children, Daniel and Sarah, all musicians.

Darrell Brown is the Director of Bands at Bradley University in Peoria, Illinois, where he also teaches courses in conducting and music education. As a conductor/composer/educator, Dr. Brown has previously held similar positions at Carroll University in Waukesha, Wisconsin, Brigham Young University-Idaho in Rexburg, Idaho, and at Del Mar College in Corpus Christi, Texas. Additionally, he has held positions as the musical director and conductor of the New Berlin Community Band, the Youth Wind Orchestra of Wisconsin, and as the assistant bandmaster of the Civil War brass band, the 1st Brigade Band, Wisconsin; the Rexburg Tabernacle Orchestra and the Idaho Falls Youth Symphony in Idaho; the Corpus Christi Municipal Band in Texas; and as the assistant director of the Utah Valley Youth Symphony Orchestra. Brown regularly serves as a guest conductor and clinician with recent engagements in Hungary, Italy, Portugal, Brazil, Cuba, and Spain, and ensembles under his direction have performed at conferences for the College Band Directors National Association (CBDNA), the National Association for Music Education (NAfME), and the Wisconsin Music Educators Association (WMEA).

Dr. Brown has taught music at the Camelot Schools in Kwekwe, Zimbabwe and in the public schools in Las Vegas, Nevada, Agua Dulce, Texas, and Provo, Utah. A student of G. Thomas Leslie, Dr. Brown received his DMA from the University of Nevada, Las Vegas, and he received his MM in Instrumental Conducting and his BM in K-12 Instrumental Music Education from Brigham Young University in Provo, Utah. As an active composer, Dr. Brown writes music for a wide array of ensembles with recent premieres at conferences of the CBDNA and the Iowa Bandmasters Association, and has music published through Murphy Music Press. Dr. Brown is a member of the National Band Association (NBA), International Society for Research and Promotion of Wind Music (IGEB), Windjammers Unlimited (The Circus Music Historical Society), NAfME, CBDNA, and is an executive board member for the international wind band organization World Association for Symphonic Bands and Ensembles (WASBE).




